now, Roman Danylo.

If awards and career longevity
count, it's no stretch to utter the
name of CTV Comedy Inc. star
Roman Danylo along with some
of Canada's comedy titans.

The Vancouver-based fun-
nyman and his CTV cast have
received two Gemini nominations
for their performance, and last
year the series won the presti-
gious Gold Medal Award for "Best
TV Variety Program" at the 2007
New York Festivals—for the third
year in a row. The series also ran
for two seasons on Spike TV in
the US.

Danylo, who performs in
Nelson this Saturday, Nov. 22
at 8 p.m. as part of the Capitol
Theatre Season Series, is on a
cross-Canada tour called Roman
Around the Country.

Billed as a variety comedy
show consisting of sketch, stand-
up, and improv, the show is both

light-hearted and edgy and takes
on various subjects—from love,
to war, to snacks at the mall food
court.

A blend of four different
genres of comedy, Danylo begins
his show with high energy obser-
vational stand-up, then incor-
porates audience members into
interactive comedy sketches, all
the while peppering in some of

his popular characters from TV.

He finishes by inviting a fellow
professional improviser to the
stage to join him in some award-
winning improvisation.

In addition to being the star
of Comedy Inc. and a regular on
the Comedy Network, Danylo has
worked the North American com-
edy scene since the early '90s,
appearing in dozens of plays,

commercials and on radio and
TV spots.

He'll be sharing some insight
into the business at an afternoon
comedy workshop at Nelson's
Oxygen Gallery Saturday from 1
to 4 p.m. Cost is \$60.
